RULES

1. May – Sept. –Only members and their guests will be permitted to tee off prior to 9:00 am on weekends.
2. Membership to the course is open to both residents and non-residents. Memberships must be purchased and are valid for the calendar year in which they are purchased.
3. *No one under the age of 10 may play on the course. Pre-teens ages 10-12 may play on the course only if accompanied by an adult.
4. Each member will be issued an I.D. card and number. This card must be brought with the golfer and displayed to cashier when purchasing green fees. Greens fees must be paid prior to play.
5. Parking and play at the golf course is at the golfer's own risk. The Township is not liable for any injuries caused by other golfers or damage caused to vehicles, which are struck by golf balls.
6. All players on the course must wear proper attire, including shirts, pants, (or shorts or skirts) and appropriate footwear.
7. Only persons golfing will be permitted on the course. Each golfer must have his/her own golf bag and clubs.
8. Golfers must obey all rules of golf etiquette. Golfers are requested to fix ball marks, replace divots and rake sand traps.
9. Practicing shall be limited to the shag field. No practicing of any kind shall be done on the actual golf course. All golfers on shag field must hit from the street towards the golf course. Golfers not abiding by this policy will be asked to leave the course or forfeit their membership.
10. Foursomes waiting to tee off must alternate with foursomes coming off the ninth green for their second nine, unless a starter is on duty and tee times have been assigned.
11. When starter is on duty, he will have control of tee-offs. All golfers will be combined into threesomes or foursomes. No singles or twosomes will be let out. When no starter is on duty, golfers should combine into threesomes or foursomes whenever possible.
12. Golfers must tee off from designated tee markers. (White-men, Red-women). Golfers are not permitted to move the tee markers.
13. Due to increased play on the course, golfers will only be permitted to play the course in a consecutive Hole 1 through 9 fashions. Taking shortcuts or eliminating holes (i.e. repeating Holes 1-9 or going from hole 2 to 7) will not be permitted.
14. Absolutely no golfing will be permitted when the course is closed. Anyone caught on the course will be considered trespassing and will be dealt with accordingly.
15. At the discretion of the Commission and Director, the course may be reserved for tournaments, league play or special events. Notice of such activities shall be posted at the clubhouse.
16. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations as set forth by the Scotch Plains Recreation Commission, or with instructions of authorized personnel and/or attendants, may result in removal from the course and/or revoking of golf privileges.
17. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be permitted on the golf course. Violators will be asked to leave the facility. Repeat offenders risk the loss of future golf privileges.
18. Electric carts may be rented for either nine or eighteen holes. Rentals for nine holes terminate at completion of round. Carts may not be rented for additional golf if others golfers are waiting for rentals.
